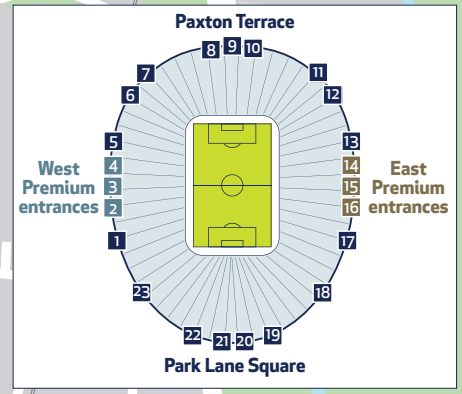
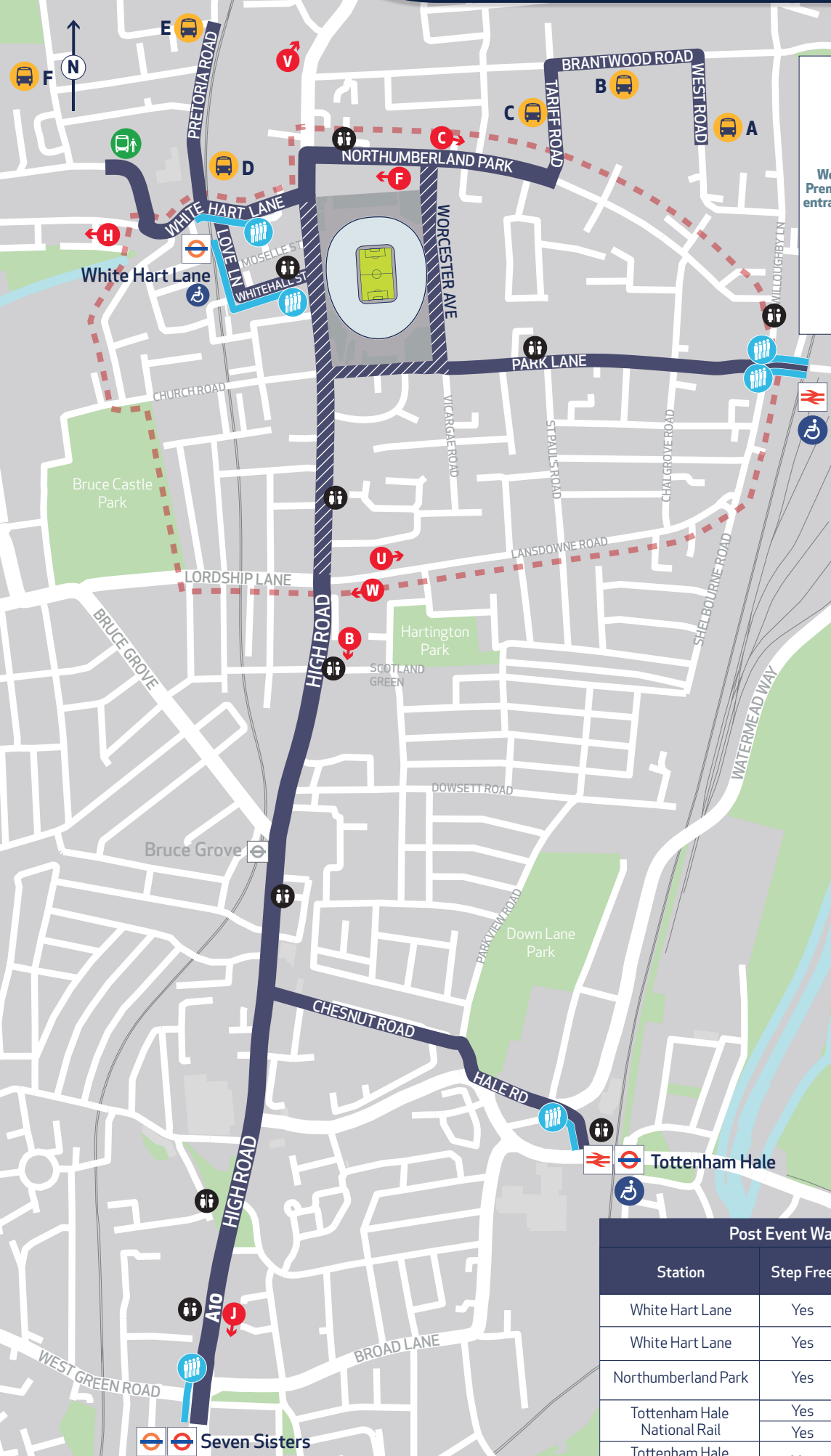


# Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Fan Transport Guide - Non-Football
